



Dear Parents & Carers.

We have arranged for Year 2 to go to The Climbing Hangar, Birchall Street, Liverpool, on **Thursday, 17 January 2019**. The Climbing Hangar is an indoor climbing centre that has a bouldering wall which is low enough not to need ropes, this means that everyone can climb at once and they can have the maximum amount of time using the wall. Indoor climbing is great for personal and social education, group work and self-esteem.

We will be travelling by coach to the centre. Group 1 will leave at 10am, returning at 12:30pm and Group 2 will leave at 12:30pm and will return in time for the end of the school day.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of **£9** for the trip. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions it may not be possible for the trip to go ahead. This will include transport to and from the Climbing Centre. The children will have 1 hour 30 minutes using the climbing walls and will be supervised by trained school staff.

The children will have their lunch as normal in school on the day. They will need to bring an extra drink and will need to bring suitable clothing to wear for the activity. Children should wear their school, outdoor PE kit. If they do not have one they can bring to school their own t-shirt, jogging trousers/leggings (no shorts) and school PE pumps with them on the day.
