I am writing to inform you of how to order your child's milk from DairyLink UK Ltd.

Please visit our company website www.dairylink-uk.com.

You have to click on the menu then the 'order milk' tab, register with us, add your child/children on the 'children' tab, then you will be able to pay for your child's milk under the 'payments' tab. The price for this will be 20p per carton (per day). **£12.66 per term or £6.33 per half term.** PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

- **THE ONLINE ORDERING IS ONLY FOR CHILDREN OVER 5 YEARS OLD WHO NEED TO PAY FOR THEIR MILK. HOWEVER WE ASK THAT YOU PAY AT THE START OF THE HALF TERM THAT YOUR CHILD TURNS 5.**
- **IF YOUR CHILD IS UNDER 5 YEARS OLD OR UNDER THE PUPIL PREMIUM SCHEME, PLEASE INFORM THE SCHOOL IF YOU WOULD LIKE FOR THEM TO RECEIVE MILK.**
- **PLEASE NOTE THAT FOR RECEPTION CHILDREN YOU WILL BE CHARGED FROM THE MONDAY OF THE WEEK THAT YOUR CHILD TURNS 5. YOU WILL NEED TO SELECT THAT DATE AS A LATE START DATE ON THE CHILDREN'S DETAILS TAB TO AVOID PAYING FOR THE FULL HALF TERM.**

Spring Term - Friday 13th December 2019

Summer Term - Friday 3rd April 2020
