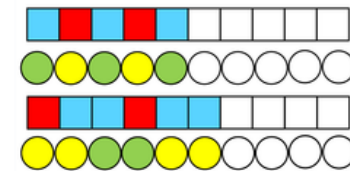
Our Theme Next Week: Magical Me
