What is under and over the ground.

Overview

The children will explore both man made and natural features that can be found under and over ground.

Engagement

The children will draw soil layers, use maps to identify the continents and learn about Isambard Kingdom Brunel.

Key Vocabulary

Tone, shading, density, pencil pressure.
Map, world, country, continent, land, oceans.

Travel, Brunel, sources, primary and secondary, steam engine, electric, past, present, modern, future, transport, goods, post.

Curriculum spotlight

Art & Design

Investigate how line can be used to add texture to drawings.

Geography

The children will locate on a map the seven continents and explore how the weather affects different jobs

History

The children will use different sources to find out information. To recognise differences and similarities

Music

The children will learn to read a simple score to count out and play rhythm patterns.

Design Technology

Children design, make and evaluate a bridge that is wide enough and strong enough to hold a food tin.
