Dear Parent/Carer,

We propose to take **Finches** to the Liverpool Watersports Centre and on **Monday, 28 June 2021**. We will be travelling by coach to the watersports centre, leaving school at 10am and leaving the watersports centre at 12:30 to return to school.

Voluntary contributions of **£20** will be necessary for the trip to go ahead. Payments can be made, if needed, in two instalments via the school money website by **Friday 4 June**. A notification will be sent to you shortly.

If your child is unfortunately absent on the day of the trip it may not be possible to refund any of the money as firm bookings will have been made in advance.

We have booked a 2 hour morning session, during which the children will be using rafted canoes. The children will all be given a buoyancy aid and helmet to wear for the activity. **The children will need to come to school wearing appropriate clothing for the activity. They will need trainers/pumps, jogging bottoms/leggings, t-shirt, jumper, waterproof coat and a small towel. Children MUST bring their uniform and shoes to change into, in a backpack with their name clearly marked.** The watersports centre will provide qualified and experienced staff to lead the session. **All health & safety risk assessments have been completed for this activity.**

Children will have a packed lunch upon return to school. All children will be provided with a packed lunch consisting of a roll - ham or cheese, small cake, 1 piece of fruit and a bottle of water. Packed lunches are prepared at school. You may if you wish provide your own healthy packed lunch for your child.

Please complete the google form for your child to take part in the activity and to indicate your child's choice of roll. Your child will not be able to go on the trip if you have not given permission. Please do this before Friday 4 June.

Pocket money - please do not give your child any money as there will be no opportunity to spend it.

If your child is ill during the trip, we may telephone you to come and collect them.
